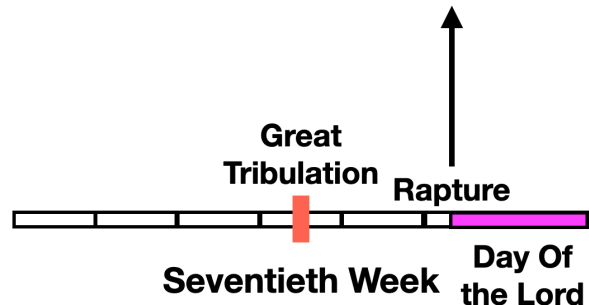
A. Isaiah’s prophecy is a message of _____ and _____.
