**Chapter 3**

A. Embracing the worthy goal of godliness is more about \_\_\_\_\_ than \_\_\_\_\_.

Worthy goal #1: **Freedom from patterns of sin.**

•**Matthew 5:6** Blessed are those who hunger and **thirst** for **righteousness**, for they will be filled.

•**Psalm 103:2** Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits —

24 For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.

יהוה - The Tetragrammaton

The Name Jehovah is derived from adding the vowels “a, o, and l” to YHWH = YaHoWaH

•**John 15:4** <sup>a</sup>**Abide** in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it **abides** in the vine, so neither *can* you, unless you **abide** in Me. “I am the vine, you are the branches; he who **abides** in Me, and I in him, he <sup>a</sup>bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.
