•**Late 19th century:** Jews began making “Aliyah” to the land of Israel.

•**1896** Theodore Herzl launches the Zionist movement.

•**1897** First Zionist Congress

•**1917** Balfour Declaration- Britain approves of Jewish Homeland in Palestine

•**World War 1-** Britain’s alliance with the Arabs delays the formation of a Jewish state.

•**1922** Britain rescinds the Balfour Declaration by issuing “the White Papers” restriction Jewish immigration into Israel.
